Bruce Allen, Golf Manager, presented the increased dollar amounts of the proposed renovations of the Max Starcke Park Golf Course. We are going to need to go out for a bond and adding personnel and equipment in the future. Staff is recommending that we stay with the full 8.6 million renovations. He said that 60% of our business are out of towners that play.

Don Keil 809 Elm Street

Want to support this measure, keeping good things in our community. A golf course is a beautiful asset to the community of Seguin.

Eric Aufderhaer 213 Lone Oak

Chairman of the Golf Advisory Board, looks at this as an investment in our future. There is a lot of talk about the expense as golfers do not want the rates to increase by \$15.00 or \$16.00. But the infrastructure is 40 plus years old. We need to make improvements, not just make repairs.

Gary Vaughan 503 South Goodrich Very excited as we do need to bring true improvements to the Golf Course. Legacies do need to be remembered. Need a true challenging golf course to bring people here and justify raising the rates.

Council Member Paul Gaytan said he loves City and that includes Starcke park golf course and the history, but based on the information I cannot support this project. Would like to become more involved with the committee, and staff to discuss in more detail. We need a Boys & Girls Club, swimming pool, etc.

Council Member Jim Lievens says a challenging golf course will help keep Seguin in spot light.

City Manager Steve Parker said Yes, it is a substantial project but if we postponed you are looking at even more expenses.

Council Member Jason Biesenbach said that he did not believe the Community at large would not support paying for a bond to make improvements to the golf course.

Mayor Dodgen said just to let you know a Boys & Girls Club is going to be a \$35 million project

Council Member Paul Gaytan said he would like to table this issue until later in January. After all the discussion it was decided to set a workshop with City Council, Golf Advisory Board, and staff in January before bringing this issue back to City Council.
