AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS AMENDING THE SEGUIN CODE OF ORDINANCES, APPENDIX C – FEE SCHEDULE, CHAPTER 74 PARKS, TO ADD A NEW FEE FOR USE OF THE SEGUIN-SAEGERT PICKLEBALL COMPLEX; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE, AND AUTHORIZING CITY STAFF TO SUBMIT THIS ORDINANCE AS A SUPPLEMENT TO THE SEGUIN CODE OF ORDINANCES

WHEREAS, the first stage of construction for the Seguin-Saegert Pickleball Complex is near completion; and

WHEREAS, city staff recommends setting fees for use of the entire complex, and for hourly court rental should use be sufficiently busy to merit a reservation system; and

WHEREAS, the recommended fees and conditions are in line for the tennis and volleyball complexes.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Seguin, Texas:

Section 1. Appendix C – Fee Schedule, Chapter 74, Parks and Recreation, of the Seguin Code of Ordinances, subsection (ii), reserved, only is amended as follows (underlining indicates added text, ~~strikethrough~~ indicates deleted text):

Section 2. This Ordinance shall become effective beginning December 1, 2022, said date being at least ten days after publication of this ordinance.

Section 3. If any clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed to be unenforceable for any reason, such unenforceable clause or provision shall be severed from the remaining portions of the Ordinance, which shall continue to have full force and effect.

Section 4. City Staff is hereby authorized to submit this Ordinance as a supplement to the Seguin Code of Ordinances.
