A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A SOLE SOURCE PURCHASE ORDER IN THE AMOUNT OF \$65,862.46 FROM EVOQUA WATER TECHNOLOGIES FOR A ROTOR BRUSH ASSEMBLY TO BE INSTALLED AT THE GERONIMO CREEK WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the rotor brush assembly at the Geronimo Creek Wastewater Treatment Plant needs to be replaced; and

WHEREAS, the rotor brush assembly is necessary for the biological treatment process that is part of the compliance process to maintain the City's Texas Pollution Discharge Elimination Systems permit that is necessary to protect the downstream flow of the Guadalupe River; and

WHEREAS, Evoqua Water Technologies is the original equipment manufacturer for the brush rotor equipment and is the sole source for that equipment; and

WHEREAS, Texas Local Government Code Section 252.022(2) allows the City to exempt from selection by competitive process procurement may be available from only one source and is needed to preserve or protect public health and safety.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

SECTION 1. The above recitals are adopted as a formal part of this resolution as if fully set forth herein.

SECTION 2. The above recitals set forth sufficient basis to declare this contract excepted from the public bidding requirement by Section 252.022 of the Texas Local Government Code.

SECTION 3. The City Manager is authorized to execute a purchase order in the amount of \$65,8662.46 for the purchase of a rotor brush assembly that is necessary for the proper operation of the Geronimo Creek Wastewater Treatment Plant.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage.
