➢ Requirements to transfer flow:

- Construction of a new raw sewage pump station
- ➢Construction of a double barrel 30" force main to include:
 - ➢ Easement acquisitions
 - ≻Two (2) Guadalupe River bores
- Expansion of the GCWWTP to 12.0 MGD capacity
 - >Upsizing of the existing outfall pipeline
 - >Acquisition of a buffer easement and outfall easement
- Demolition of the WBWWTP
