**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS
AUTHORIZING CITY STAFF TO DISPOSE OF SURPLUS PROPERTY THAT IS
OBSOLETE, DYSFUNCTIONAL OR TOO COSTLY TO REPAIR; AND
DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

WHEREAS, from time-to-time various items of property owned by the City become obsolete, dysfunctional or in need costly repairs that render the item unusable; and

WHEREAS, City policy dictates that the City Council approve the sale of items with a cost of \$5,000.00 or more; and

WHEREAS, the items provided in the attached memorandum, Exhibit A, are no longer useable by the City; and

WHEREAS, City staff recommend that all items be placed on the public online auction site, GovDeals.com and sold to the highest bidder.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby declares that the item is surplus and of no net economic benefit to the City.

SECTION 2. City staff are directed to place surplus items listed in Exhibit A on the public online auction site, GovDeals.com and sold to the highest bidder.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage.
