**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS, GRANTING A FIVE YEAR FRANCHISE AGREEMENT TO ALAMO DISPOSAL, REPUBLIC SERVICES, WASTE MANAGEMENT, TEXAS DISPOSAL SYSTEMS, WASTE CONENCTIONS, AND TIGER SANITATIONS FOR THE OPERATION OF COMMERCIAL SOLID WASTE AND RECYCLING COLLECTION SERVICES WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

**WHEREAS**, the current solid waste franchise agreements with Waste Connections Lone Star, Republic Services, Tiger Sanitation, and Apache Disposal expire December 31, 2026; and

**WHEREAS**, the city released a Request for Proposals for a five-year franchise agreement for the collection of commercial and industrial solid waste and recycling within the City; and

**WHEREAS**, to increase competitiveness and serve the city's growth the Solid Waste Committee recommends awarding franchise agreements for up to six vendors; and

**WHEREAS**, after reviewing the responses to the Request for Proposal, the Committee recommends awarding franchises to: Alamo Disposal, Republic Services, Waste Management, Texas Disposal Systems, Waste Connections, and Tiger Sanitation.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Seguin:

**SECTION 1.** A five-year commercial solid waste franchise, with two optional three-year extensions, is awarded to Alamo Disposal, Republic Services, Waste Management, Texas Disposal Systems, Waste Connections, and Tiger Sanitation.

**SECTION 2.** Upon receipt of the required certificates of insurance, and a signed Franchise Agreement, the City Manager, Steve Parker, is authorized to execute a Franchise Agreement with each of the six companies.

**SECTION 3.** For the purposes of the franchises, this Resolution is effective beginning January 1, 2027.
