SUBJECT: Creekside Street conversion to one-way

DATE: January 26, 2016

As part of the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) Statewide Transportation Enhancement Program (STEP) hike and bike trail that we were awarded, it was necessary utilize part of the width of the existing Creekside Street right-of-way (ROW) to accommodate the pedestrian and bicycle elements of the hike and bike trail. Due to the existing narrow width of the existing ROW and pavement section, we had to commit to TxDOT to agree to convert Creekside Street to one-way, from San Antonio Avenue to North Vaughn Avenue. Fortunately, there are low traffic counts for that short section of street and there are only five driveways that have access directly to Creekside Street. The hike and bike trail along Creekside Street will consist of a five-foot wide sidewalk and two four-foot wide bicycle lanes. Creekside will become one-way, in a southeasterly direction, from San Antonio Avenue towards North Vaughn Avenue. Staff recommends the conversion of Creekside Street from San Antonio Avenue to North Vaughn Avenue as required to meet the requirements of the hike and bike trail.
