Crossroads Boulevard Lift Station Project

Dear Mr. Howe.

We have reviewed both the D&D Contractors, Inc. (D&D) and Qro Mex Construction Company, Inc. (QroMex) Reference and Qualification Packages. In addition, we have contacted references listed in the packages from prior projects for both contractors.

Although QroMex was the second lowest bidder, based upon our review of the qualifications and references, it is our opinion that Qro Mex Construction Company, Inc. is the lowest responsible bidder for the Crossroads Boulevard Lift Station Project.

While D&D Contractors, Inc. submitted the lowest bid, Kimley-Horn considers them non-responsive for the following reasons.

- Per 00301 General Conditions of Bidding Section 10. Bidders must use bid form provided in specifications. D&D used a different bid form, therefore City of Seguin reserves the right to accept or reject the bid for "Failure to use the bid/proposal form furnished by the City of Seguin".
- Per 00451 Qualifications Statement Article 8.04 Requires a minimum of three (3) projects completed within the last 5 years that demonstrate experience with projects similar to in type and cost of construction. D&D only submitted one lift station project and all other projects in our opinion were not considered similar.
