

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS AWARDING A BID IN THE AMOUNT OF \$353,390.73 TO RUCOBA & MAYA CONSTRUCTION, LLC FOR THE SOUTH CAMP STREET DRAINAGE PROJECT; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WITH RUCOBA & MAYA CONSTRUCTION, LLC; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, a street inlet and outfall at South Camp Street near the West Washington Street intersection of Walnut Branch causes damage to residential lots near the area during heavy rain events due to inadequate capacity; and

WHEREAS, the City previously authorized a professional services agreement with Halff Associates, Inc. for professional services for the drainage improvement project; and

WHEREAS, in response to the City's request the City received seven sealed bids for the South Camp Street Drainage Improvements Project; and

WHEREAS, the qualified bids ranged from a low base bid of \$321,264.30 submitted by Rucoba & Maya Construction, LLC to a high of \$413,625.52 submitted by D&D Contractors; and

WHEREAS, after considering the bids, performing an extensive reference check by Halff Associates, Inc. and evaluation bid amount per unit price, the City recommends awarding the contract to the lowest bidder Rucoba & Maya Construction, LLC for the bid price of \$321,264.30, plus \$32,126.43 in contingency for a total amount of \$353,390.73.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby awards the contract in the amount of \$353,390.73 to Rucoba & Maya Construction, LLC for the South Camp Street Drainage Improvements Project.

SECTION 2. The City Manager, Steve Parker, is authorized to execute a construction contract with Rucoba & Maya Construction, LLC for the South Camp Street Drainage Improvements Project.

SECTION 3. This resolution is effective on the date of its passing.
