RE: Disposal of Surplus Property

According to the Disposal of Assets Policy, previously approved by City Council on September 16, 2014, sale or disposal of surplus property requires prior approval by the City Manager. Any items whose original cost of \$5,000 or more which have become obsolete, dysfunctional, or are otherwise too costly to repair may be disposed of following City Council approval.
