A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS APPROVING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION TO THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR HOMELAND SECURITY DIVISION FOR A GRANT FROM THE LAW ENFORCEMENT TERRORISM PREVENTION ACTIVITIES PROGRAM; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE SUBMISSION; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the Governor's Office Division of Homeland Security has offered a grant program through the Law Enforcement Terrorism Prevention Activities program (the "LEPTA Program"); and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the LEPTA Program is to enhance local law enforcement agencies' in their ability to fight crime and particularly terroristic crimes; and

WHEREAS, the police department is in need of riot gear to assist in their operations; and

WHEREAS, the police department is requesting a grant in the amount of \$19,494.37 for the purchase of riot gear; and

WHEREAS, matching funds are not required for this grant; and

WHEREAS, city staff requests approval for the submission of the grant application.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

SECTION 1. The City Council of the City of Seguin authorizes City Manager, Douglas G. Faseler, to submit a grant application to the Office of the Governor Division of Homeland Security, Law Enforcement Terrorism Prevention Activities.

SECTION 2. The City Council directs and designates the City Manager as the City's Chief Executive Officer and Authorized Representative to act in all matters in connection with the City's participation in the grant program.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage.
