CITY OF SEGUIN

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF SEGUIN, TEXAS AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT FOR JOINT USE OF PROPERTY BETWEEN THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS AND THE SEGUIN INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING RECREATIONAL, CULTURAL, EDUCATIONAL, AND ATHLETIC OPPORTUNITIES FOR THE RESIDENTS OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN AND THE SEGUIN INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Seguin and Seguin Independent School District need to renew their agreements related to after-school, summer camp and athletics programs; and

WHEREAS, the Parties have determined that consolidating the agreements they have into one Master Agreement would provide clarity and minimize the possibility for conflicts in contract terms between Interlocal Cooperation Agreements; and

WHEREAS, the Master Agreement allows the Parties to utilize each other's facilities for key programs that fulfill the public purpose of both the City and SISD; and

WHEREAS, Staff recommends authorizing the City Manager to execute the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS:

SECTION 1: The City Council authorizes the City Manager to execute an Interlocal Cooperation Agreement for Joint Use of Property between the City of Seguin and Seguin Independent School District.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage.
