**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS
APPROVING A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF
\$2,803,100.00 WITH KIMLEY-HORN AND ASSOCIATES, INC. FOR ENGINEERING
SERVICES RELATED TO THE 24-INCH SH-46 WESTERN TRANSMISSION MAIN
PROJECT; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

WHEREAS, the 24-inch SH-46 western transmission main will connect the ground water and surface water systems at the discharge side of the high service and surface water pump stations; and

WHEREAS, it will fully integrate the ground water and surface water systems and provides near full redundancy between the two systems; and

WHEREAS, this project is triggered by increased demand in the upper pressure plane and the Springs Hill CCN transfer area; and

WHEREAS, a professional services proposal was obtained from Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc. for project management, engineering design services, bidding phase, construction phase, and project close out services; and

WHEREAS, City staff recommends approving the professional services proposal in the amount of \$2,803,100.00 submitted by Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc.; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

Part 1. The City Council of Seguin, Texas hereby approves the professional services agreement in the amount of \$2,803,100.00 submitted by Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc.

Part 2. The City Council finds that Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc. is an appropriate professional service provider for the Project based on its demonstrated competence and qualifications, and that the proposed price for this Project is fair and reasonable.

Part 3. The City Manager is authorized to execute the professional services agreement with Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc. for the engineering services related to the 24-inch SH-46 Western Transmission Main Project.

Part 4. This Resolution is effective from and after the date of its passing.
