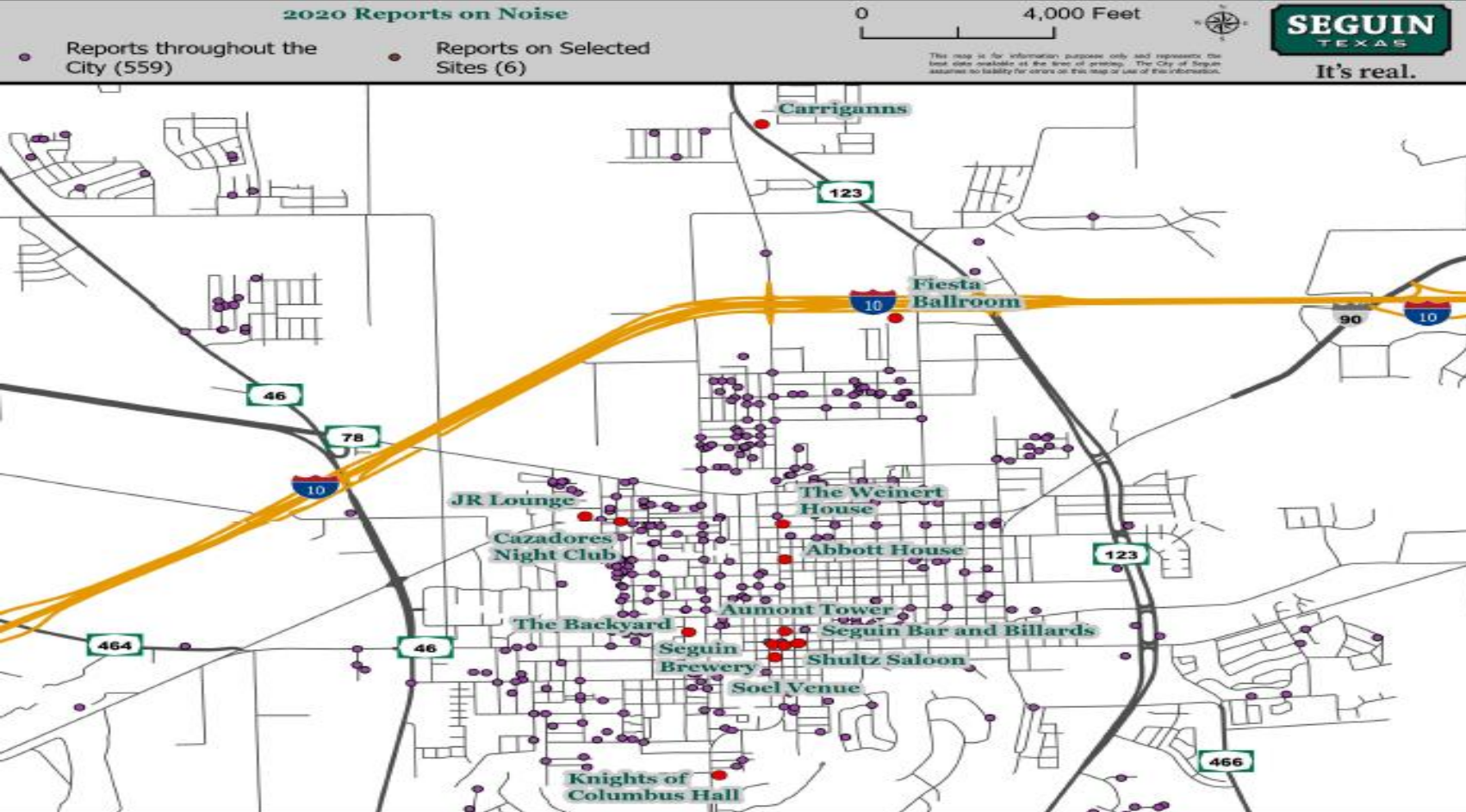

SEGUIN NOISE ORDINANCE

- **Decibel Limits**
 - 63 decibels, 70 decibels, 72 decibels (Residential, Mixed/Commercial Use, Industrial)
- **Distance Limit**
 - Unlawful between 10:00 pm and 7:00 am to produce sound plainly audible at a distance of 100 feet
- **Vibration Limit**
 - Unlawful to create vibration at a distance of 50 feet
- **Noise Nuisance**
 - Playing of a . . . radio . . . instrument . . . sound amplifier . . . that annoys, distresses, or disturbs the quiet, comfort, or repose of any person.
 - Numerous other prohibited noises such as loud language, animals, horns, audible advertising, raucous shouting.

SAN MARCOS NOISE ORDINANCE

- **Commercial Property**
 - **Decibel Limits**
 - 85 decibels between 10:00 am and 10:00 pm
 - 75 decibels between 10:00 pm and 10:00 am

NEW BRAUNFELS NOISE ORDINANCE

- **Residential District**
 - 85 decibels from 10:00 am to 10:00 pm
 - 75 decibels all other times
- **Nonresidential Property**
 - **Music Venues**
 - Not located within 100 feet of a residential district – 85 decibels
 - Located within 100 feet of residential district – 85 decibels (10:00 am through 10:00 pm), 80 decibels all other times
 - **All Other Nonresidential Property**
 - Not located within 100 feet of residential district – 85 decibels at all times
 - Located within 100 feet of residential district– 85 decibels (10:00 am through 10:00 pm), 75 decibels all other times

CIBOLO NOISE ORDINANCE

- **Residential District**
 - 85 decibels from 10:00 am to 10:00 pm
 - 75 decibels all other times
- **Nonresidential Property**
 - **Music Venues**
 - Not located within 150 feet of a residential district – 85 decibels
 - Located within 150 feet of residential district – 85 decibels (10:00 am through 10:00 pm), 75 decibels all other times
 - **All Other Nonresidential Property**
 - Not located within 150 feet of residential district – 85 decibels at all times
 - Located within 150 feet of residential district– 85 decibels (10:00 am through 10:00 pm), 75 decibels all other times

SCHERTZ NOISE ORDINANCE

Unlawful to play a radio ... similar device or musical instrument between 10:00 pm and 7:00 am that disturbs the quiet, comfort or repose of ordinary persons.

Use of any stationary loud speaker or amplifier that disturbs ordinary sensibilities of a person between 10:00 pm and 7:00 am.

UNIVERSAL CITY NOISE ORDINANCE

- **Use of any stationary loud speaker or amplifier that annoys or disturbs ordinary sensibilities of a person between 10:00 pm and 7:00 am.**

CONVERSE NOISE ORDINANCE

- **Unlawful to play any radio . . . musical instrument, or device emitting a musical beat as to annoy, distress, or disturb the quiet, comfort, or repose of normal persons.**

OUTDOOR FESTIVAL PERMITS

- **Required for outdoor concerts, carnivals, trade shows, or other outdoor events:**
 - *Where performances or the audience are not located within a permanent structure; and*
 - *Where the performance is located on property other than City owned parks & facilities, permanent campuses including church and school facilities, or other permanent locations designed to accommodate mass gatherings.*
 - *Not allowed in residential-zoned districts.*
 - *Regulations adopted in the Unified Development Code (UDC), Section 2.15.*
- **Submitted to the Planning & Codes Department.**
 - *Reviewed by Planning & Codes, Fire, and Police.*
- **Required to comply with the local noise ordinance. (Not Exempt)**

SPECIFIC USE PERMITS

- **Required for certain land uses (identified in the zoning regulations):**
 - *Examples- outdoor amusement facilities, vet clinics w/ outside pens, kennels, event facilities in R-1/R-2*
 - *Regulations adopted in the Unified Development Code (UDC), Section 3.4*
- **Requires approval by the Planning & Zoning Commission.**
 - *Notifications sent to surrounding properties; public hearing held at the P&Z meeting.*
- **Conditions can be placed on the permit to protect surrounding properties from nuisances.**
 - *Conditions of the permit are enforced by the Planning & Codes Dept.*
- **Events are required to comply with the local noise ordinance. (Not Exempt)**

SPECIAL EVENT PERMITS

- **Required for large events that take place in City streets or on City-owned properties.**
 - *Some events require Facility Rentals.*
 - *Requirements vary based on type of event.*
- **Submitted to the Parks Dept.**
 - *Events downtown are submitted to the Main Street Dept.*
- **Reviewed by Parks and/or Main Street, Fire, and Police**
- **Required to comply with the local noise ordinance. (Not Exempt)**
