CITY OF SEGUIN

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS, APPROVING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE LOCAL BORDER SECURITY PROGRAM TO SUPPORT ADDITIONAL DRUG INTERDICTION EFFORTS ON CITY HIGHWAYS; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Seguin finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Seguin that the Local Border Security Program (Grant No. 2996201) be operated for the 2016 grant cycle; and

WHEREAS, the City of Seguin agrees to provide any applicable matching funds for the said project as required by the Homeland Security Grants Division grant application; and

WHEREAS, the City of Seguin agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Homeland Security Grants Division funds, the City of Seguin assures that the funds will be returned to the Homeland Security Grants Division in full; and

WHEREAS, the provision of additional manpower to police the City's major highways will benefit the citizens of and visitors to Seguin.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby approves the submission of the grant application for the Local Border Security Program to the Office of the Governor, Homeland Security Grants Division.

SECTION 2. The City Council hereby designates the City Manager as the grantee's authorized official who is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is in full force and effect from and after the date of passage.
