**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS,  
AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION IN RESPONSE TO  
THE OFFICE OF THE SECRETARY OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE SAFE  
STREETS AND ROADS FOR ALL DISCRETIONARY GRANT**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Seguin desires that standards and policies ensure the safe, equitable, and adequate accommodation of all users of our roadways; and

**WHEREAS**, to develop a comprehensive, safety action plan aimed at preventing roadway fatalities and injuries the City needs to consider grant opportunities to fund an action plan; and

**WHEREAS**, a grant opportunity, Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) is available for action plan development for up to \$1,000,000 with a required match of 20%. City Council approval is required to apply for this grant; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Seguin has previously authorized the City Manager to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate a grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS:**

**SECTION 1:** The City Council authorizes the submission of a grant application to the FY22 Safe Streets and Roads for All discretionary grant.

**SECTION 2:** The City Council reaffirms, directs, and designates the City Manager as the City's Authorized Official to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate this grant and to act in all matters in connection with this application and the City's participation in the Grant Program.

**SECTION 3:** Expenditures of the grant shall be administered in compliance with the grant guidelines and all applicable state and federal guidance.

**SECTION 4.** This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage.
