A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF SEGUIN AND THE CITY OF CIBOLO FOR THE ALLOCATION AND PROVISION OF FIRE PROTECTION AND FOR MUTUAL AID

WHEREAS, Guadalupe County (the "County") contracts with the City of Seguin for the provision of fire protection in the unincorporated areas of the County; and

WHEREAS, the City of Seguin and the City of Cibolo have previously entered into an interlocal agreement wherein the two cities split up the unincorporated areas in order to provide efficient and timely service for fire protection and call response; and

WHEREAS, the Seguin will receive a gross annual sum of \$350,000.00 from Guadalupe County for providing fire protection in the unincorporated areas of the County; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends that Seguin pay Cibolo an annual sum of \$33,453.08 in monthly payments of \$2,787.75, for Cibolo's service to an agreed area of the unincorporated area of Guadalupe County; and

WHEREAS, it is the public interest that the City of Seguin and the City of Cibolo enter into the attached Interlocal Agreement for the provision of fire protection and mutual aid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin:

PART 1. The City Manager is authorized to execute the attached Interlocal Agreement for the allocation of fire protection and mutual aid between the Cities of Seguin and the City of Cibolo.

PART 2. This resolution is effective retroactively beginning October 1, 2020.
