AMENDED RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACT IN ALL MATTERS IN CONNECTION WITH THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR HOMELAND SECURITY GRANTS DIVISION FOR THE LOCAL BORDER SECURITY PROGRAM (LBSP) GRANT NUMBER 2996205

WHEREAS, on May 21, 2019, the City Council approved the application to the Office of the Governor for a grant in the amount of \$20,800.00 through the then named Border Star Program; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the Governor Criminal Justice Division has awarded a FY 2020 Local Border Security Program Grant in the amount of \$20,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of Seguin has previously designated the City Manager as the City's Chief Executive Office and Authorized Representative; and

WHEREAS, this Amended Resolution authorizes the City Manager to act in all matters concerning this grant

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

SECTION 1. The City Council of the City of Seguin authorizes City Manager, to amend the grant from the Office of the Governor for the Local Border Security Program.

SECTION 2. The City Council directs and designates the City Manager as the City's Chief Executive Officer and Authorized Representative to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate and act in all matters in connection with the City's participation in the grant program.

SECTION 3. The City Council agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Office of the Governor Funds, the City Council assures that the funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor in full.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage.
