A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$453,785.40 WITH PAPE-DAWSON ENGINEERS FOR THE SEGUIN PEDESTRIAN IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT (CSJ 0915-46-053); AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Seguin is a member of the Alamo Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (the "AAMPO"); and

WHEREAS, in February 2022, the City was notified by the AAMPO that the Seguin Pedestrian Improvements Project (the "Project") was selected for funding; and

WHEREAS, the services to be performed by Pape-Dawson Engineers for the Project includes plans, specifications and estimates for the Seguin Pedestrian Improvements Project; and

WHEREAS, City staff have negotiated a professional services agreement with Pape-Dawson Engineers for the Seguin Pedestrian Improvement Project; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends entering into a professional services agreement for this Project pursuant to the Agreement with Pape-Dawson Engineers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Seguin hereby approves a Professional Services Agreement in the amount of \$453,785.40 with Pape-Dawson Engineers for the Seguin Pedestrian Improvements Project.

Section 2. The City Manager, Steve Parker, is authorized to execute an agreement with Pape-Dawson Engineers for the Seguin Pedestrian Improvements Project.

Section 3. The City Manager is authorized to execute service amendments within contingency as allowed.

Section 4. This resolution is effective on the date of its passing.
