## STATE OF TEXAS

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS APPROVING THE 2025-2026 MANAGEMENT SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF SEGUIN AND THE SEGUIN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION

**WHEREAS**, the Seguin Economic Development Corporation (the "SEDC") is a public instrumentality and non-profit industrial development corporation duly established and operating under Texas Local Government Code, Chapters 501 and 504, et seq., as amended, known as the Development Corporation Act of 1979 (the "Act"); and

**WHEREAS**, the purpose of the Management Services Agreement is to define the terms under which the City of Seguin provides administrative, financial, and professional staffing services to the SEDC in support of its operations and programs; and

**WHEREAS**, the Agreement outlines roles and responsibilities for financial management, staff support, and program execution, and formalizes oversight procedures consistent with the SEDC Bylaws; and

**WHEREAS**, on September 11, 2025, the SEDC Board of Directors passed Resolution No. 2025-10, approving the Management Services Agreement between the SEDC and the City for Fiscal Year 2025–2026; and

**WHEREAS**, the proposed Agreement will be effective for a one-year term beginning on October 1, 2025, and ending on September 30, 2026;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

**SECTION 1.** The Seguin City Council hereby finds that all the recitals above are true and correct and are incorporated herein as if restated in full.

**SECTION 2.** The Management Services Agreement between the City and the SEDC for Fiscal Year 2025–2026, attached as Exhibit "A", covering the period from October 1, 2025 through September 30, 2026, is hereby approved, and the City Manager, Steve Parker, is authorized to execute the Agreement on behalf of the City.

**SECTION 3.** This resolution is effective on the date of its passing.
