**Subject:** **Resolution to enter into a fixed price joint participation agreement with TxDOT for planned intersection improvements to Highway 466 and Eastwood Road**  
**Date:** January 17, 2023

The City received notice from the Texas Department of Transportation late in 2022 requesting authorization of a resolution to enter into a joint participation agreement and monetary contribution to allow the State highway improvement project at Highway 466 and Eastwood Road. The local cost participation is requested at ten percent of the total project costs. Currently the State is requesting cost participation for right of way acquisition (10% of total) in the amount of \$3,243.81.

In May of 2015, Seguin City Council approved a resolution urging the Texas Department of Transportation to conduct an appropriate study and subsequently install traffic control devices at the intersection of Preston Drive and FM 466 (Eastwood Drive).

Staff recommends approval of the requested resolution.
