

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS,
AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF A 2016 VIOLENT CRIMES AGAINST WOMEN
CRIMINAL JUSTICE AND TRAINING PROJECTS GRANT PROGRAM APPLICATION TO
THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE DIVISION OF THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE**

WHEREAS, the City of Seguin recognizes the need for Criminal Investigators dedicated solely to violent crimes against women; and

WHEREAS, the City of Seguin desires to submit an application for a grant to support the salary, benefits, equipment, and training costs of two Criminal Investigators in the amount of \$155,810 from the 2016 Violent Crimes Against Women Criminal Justice and Training Projects Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Seguin agrees to provide the applicable matching funds required by the Training Grant, with said funds being budgeted in the personnel budget of the police department; and

WHEREAS, the City of Seguin has authorized the City Manager to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS,
as follows:

The City of Seguin authorizes the submission of an application to the Governor's Office Criminal Justice Division's 2016 Violent Crimes Against Women Criminal Justice and Training Projects Grant Program for funding the salary, benefits, equipment, and training costs of two Criminal Investigators.

The City Council directs and designates the City Manager as the City's Chief Executive Officer and Authorized Representative to act in all matters in connection with this application and the City's participation in the Grant Program.

Expenditures of the grant shall be administered in compliance with the Criminal Justice Division guidelines and terms and conditions of the grant award. The City Manager will assure that the grant funds are expended in accordance with said guidelines. In the event of loss or misuse of Criminal Justice Division funds, the City of Seguin assures that funds will be returned to the Criminal Justice Division in full.

This resolution amends the Resolution passed February 17, 2015, and is hereby effective as of that date.
