A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE PETITION FOR RELEASE FROM THE CITY'S EXTRATERRITORIAL JURISDICTION FILED BY DERWIN AND KATHERINE SYZDEK FOR ONE PARCEL OF LAND WITH PROPERTY ID NO. 28879 ALONG US HWY 90, AND GRANTING THE REQUEST FOR RELEASE EFFECTIVE THE DATE OF THE PASSING OF THIS RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, during the 2023 session the Texas Legislature passed Senate Bill 2038 wherein a landowner could petition a municipality for release of their property from the City's extraterritorial jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, Derwin and Katherine Syzdek filed a Petition for release from the City's extraterritorial jurisdiction for one parcel of land with Property ID No. 28879, totaling approximately 0.2772-acres of land located on Us Hwy 90, Kingsbury, Texas; and

WHEREAS, Derwin and Katherine Syzdek have presented the City with a Petition for Release from the City's extraterritorial jurisdiction that meets the requisites of the Statute; and

WHEREAS, the Petition submitted by Derwin and Katherine Syzdek meets the requisites of the new law.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Seguin, Texas:

PART 1. The Petition for release of one parcel of land owned by Derwin and Katherine Syzdek is accepted.

PART 2. The parcel of land being 0.2772-acres situated on Lot 1, the south 105' and the eastern 25' of Lot 2, Block 31, of the Town of Kingsbury, Property ID No. 28879, and as more particularly described in the property map, is hereby released from the extraterritorial jurisdiction of the City of Seguin.

PART 3. City staff are hereby directed to amend the official maps of the City of Seguin to reflect the above release of land from the City's extraterritorial jurisdiction.

PART 4. This Resolution is in full force and effect beginning June 5, 2024.
