A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF SEGUIN, TEXAS DIRECTING THAT PARALLEL PARKING ON THE WEST BOUND SIDE OF THE 100 AND 200 BLOCK OF EAST NOLTE AND THE 300 BLOCK OF SOUTH RIVER STREET BE CONVERTED TO ANGLE PARKING

WHEREAS, ample parking for downtown businesses is crucial for their continued success; and

WHEREAS, under the proposed plan converting some of the downtown parallel parking to angle parking can create nine additional spaces for public parking and additional handicap parking; and

WHEREAS, the Main Street Advisory Board along with the Historic Design Review Committee recommend increasing the number of parking spaces by converting parallel parking to angle parking where practical; and

WHEREAS, the city engineer has determined that the paved right-of-way for the 100 and 200 block of East Nolte, and the 300 Block of South River Street is sufficiently wide to safely convert one side of the street to angle parking.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Seguin, Texas:

PART 1. In accordance with Section 98-94 of the Seguin Code of Ordinances the City Council hereby directs that parallel parking on the west bound side of the 100 and 200 blocks of East Nolte, and the south bound side of the 300 block of South River Street be converted to angle parking in accordance with the drawings for each street block that are attached as exhibits to this Resolution.

PART 2. The public works manager working through the city engineer shall restripe the streets set forth above in Part 1 for angle parking; and shall erect all necessary signs.

PART 3. This Resolution is in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage.
