**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS
AWARDING A BID IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,372,685.00 TO D&S
CONCRETE CONTRACTORS, LLC FOR THE 8th STREET EXTENSION PROJECT
THROUGH THE THROUGH THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE'S ECONOMIC
DEVELOPMENT ADMINISTRATION (EDA) CARES ACT RECOVERY ASSISTANCE
GRANT; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONSTRUCTION
CONTRACT WITH D&S CONCRETE CONTRACTORS, LLC; AND DECLARING AN
EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, the City was awarded a \$860,000.00 CARES Act Recovery Assistance Grant through the U.S. Department of Commerce's Economic Development Administration (EDA) to extend 8th Street; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the grant the City issued a Request for Proposals receiving two sealed bids on the opening date of May 3, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the two bids ranged from a low base bid of \$1,372,685.00 from D&S Concrete Contractors, LLC to a high base bid of \$1,548,378.50.00 from E-Z Bel Construction, LLC; and

WHEREAS, city staff along with Pape Dawson, the city's consulting engineer for the project, reviewed the two bids as well as the experience and references for each of the two bidders; and

WHEREAS, based on references and experience with similar projects staff and the City's consultant recommend awarding the bid to the low bidder, D&S Concrete Contractors, LLC.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

SECTION 1. The bid for the 8th Street Extension Project through the U.S. Department of Commerce's Economic Development Administration CARES Act Recovery Assistance grant in the amount of \$1,372,685.00 is awarded to D&S Concrete Contractors, LLC.

SECTION 2. The City Manager, Steve Parker, is authorized to enter into a construction contract for \$1,372,685.00 with D&S Concrete Contractors, LLC. for the 8th Street Extension Project.

SECTION 3. This resolution is effective on the date of its passing.
