**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS  
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A QUIET ZONE  
REIMBURSEMENT AGREEMENT IN AN ESTIMATED AMOUNT OF \$50,000 WITH  
UNION PACIFIC RAILROAD FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE RAILROAD QUIET  
ZONES PROJECT; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the City wishes to implement a Quiet Zone in the area within a railroad section between the railroad crossings at Rudeloff Road and Heideke Street; and

**WHEREAS**, Union Pacific Railroad requires a Public Authority to enter into a Reimbursement Agreement prior to initiating any evaluations or meeting with the Authority; and

**WHEREAS**, city staff have negotiated a professional services agreement with Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc. for the purposes of evaluation, design, and related functions required for the development of plans and specifications for establishing a Quiet Zone per Federal Railroad Administration guidelines; and

**WHEREAS**, city staff recommends entering into a Reimbursement Agreement for Quiet Zone Services for this Project pursuant to the Agreement with Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

**SECTION 1.** The City Council of Seguin, Texas hereby approves a Reimbursement Agreement in the estimated amount of \$50,000 with Union Pacific Railroad required for services related to the establishment of a Quiet Zone per Federal Railroad Administration guidelines.

**SECTION 2.** This resolution is effective on the date of its passing.
