A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS APPROVING A PROPOSAL FROM D&D SITEWORK AND UTILITIES RELATED TO REPLACEMENT OF A 84-INCH CORRUGATED STEEL STORM SEWER PIPE ON NOLAN STREET; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, 110 linear feet of pipe has degraded and failed, causing a hazard on Nolan Street. Additionally, storm inlets have caused erosion within the Nolan Street pavement section; and

WHEREAS, staff consulted with prospective contractors, receiving comprehensive proposals from D&D Sitework and Utilities and D&M Construction; and

WHEREAS, due to the condition and location of the pipe and road failures, this particular contract is eligible for exemption from formal procurement pursuant to Section 252.032(a)(1) and (a)(2) of the Texas Local Government Code; and

WHEREAS, city staff recommend approval of D&D Sitework and Utilities proposal, which will have a total budgetary impact of \$230,000, including work to be performed by City forces; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

SECTION 1. The proposal from D&D Sitework and Utilities is hereby approved, and Public Works is authorized to contract with D&D Sitework and Utilities to repair the storm sewer pipe on Nolan Street, in an amount of \$199,789.34, and is hereby exempted from formal procurement pursuant to Section 252.022 (a)(1), (2), and (3) of the Texas Local Government Code.

SECTION 2. Public Works shall utilize its paving crew to repair Nolan Street after D&D Sitework and Utilities has completed its work, with an estimated cost of \$30,240.66 for the paving work.

SECTION 3. This resolution is effective on the date of its passing.
