## A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF SEGUIN TEXAS APPROVING THE PURCHASE THROUGH THE HGACBUY PURCHASING COOPERATIVE OF A REPLACEMENT ASPHALT ZIPPER INCLUDING THE TRADE-IN OF THE CURRENT CITY OWNED ASPHALT ZIPPER; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS**, in February 2016 the City purchased an Asphalt Zipper machine to use for a wide variety of street rehabilitation projects; and

**WHEREAS**, the Zipper machine has worked very well and public works staff has worked well with the manufacturer to keep the machine operating at a high level; and

**WHEREAS**, the Zipper machine has developed a crack in the frame necessitating repair in order to continue the high level of operation needed for city projects; and

**WHEREAS**, the repair cost would be about \$30,000 and take the machine out of use for a period of time; and

**WHEREAS,** the Zipper company has offered to pay the City \$72,000 as a trade in against a new machine that would be a net cost of \$163,515.00, while allowing the city to borrow a machine in the interim.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of Seguin, Texas:

**SECTION ONE.** The City Council hereby approves the purchase of an Asphalt Zipper through the HGACBuy Purchasing Cooperative in the amount of \$163,515.00.

**SECTION TWO.** The City Manager, Steve Parker, is authorized to execute all documents necessary to effectuate the purchase.

**SECTION THREE.** This Resolution is effective on and after its approval.
