A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$154,000 WITH SENERGY FOR ELECTRIC SUPPORT AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, SEnergy will provide Electrical support including but not limited to System Fusing Study (\$36,000), Financial Services (\$38,000), Power Planning Support (\$38,000), Regulatory Services/Agency Tracking and Compliance Support (\$18,000), Electrical System Planning (\$14,000), and General Energy Services support (\$10,000). These services will guide Electrical Utilities in areas of rate recommendation, power supply planning, regulatory services/compliance, electrical distribution planning, and system fusing study, which will provide the necessary information needed for the exponential growth of Seguin; and

WHEREAS, The funding source for this Professional Services agreement will come from the Electrical Distribution FY 2025-26 Operating Budget; and

WHEREAS, City Staff recommends the agreement be executed with SEnergy in the amount of \$154,000; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

Part 1. The purchase of a Professional Services Agreement for \$154,000 with SEnergy.

Part 2. The City Council finds SEnery an appropriate professional service provider based on its demonstrated competence and qualifications, and the proposed compensation for these services is fair and reasonable.

Part 2. This resolution is effective from and after the date of its passing.
