

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE SEGUIN CODE OF ORDINANCES CHAPTER 98, TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES, ARTICLE IV, SECTION 98-105, LIMITED TIME PARKING, BY DESIGNATING THE EAST SIDE OF THE 100 BLOCK OF SOUTH TRAVIS STREET AS RESERVED SPACES FOR GUADALUPE COUNTY ELECETED OFFICIALS AND LAW ENFORCEMENT PERSONNEL; PROVIDING FOR THE EFFECTIVE DATE; PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION; AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF

WHEREAS, the Seguin Main Street Advisory Board has recommended that the City establish restricted parking on the east side of South Travis Street in the 100 block;

WHEREAS, the Seguin City Council has recommended that the City establish restricted parking on the east side of South Travis Street in the 100 block.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas, as follows:

1. That the seven parking spaces on the east side of the 100 block of South Travis Street shall be restricted and parking reserved for Guadalupe County elected officials and law enforcement personnel only.
2. City staff is hereby directed to place signs on the east side of the 100 block of South Travis Street in accordance with this ordinance.
3. Violations of this Ordinance shall be punished in accordance with the penalty provisions of the City of Seguin Code of Ordinances.
4. In accordance with Section 3.10 of the Seguin City Charter, this Ordinance shall become effective upon ten (10) days following passage on second reading and shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation.
5. If any clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed to be unenforceable for any reason, such unenforceable clause or provision shall be severed from the remaining portion of the Ordinance, which shall continue to have full force and effect.
