RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH SULLIVAN CONTRACTING SERVICES., A CHOICE PARTNERS PURCHASING COOP MEMBER, FOR THE RENOVATION OF AN OFFICE INTO A NEW NARCOTICS EVIDENCE STORAGE ROOM IN THE POLICE STATION, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$59,982.49, AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, authorization would allow a more efficient and safer operation of the Seguin Police Department's evidence and storage room; and

WHEREAS, funding for this renovation has been budgeted in the FY2025 budget; and

WHEREAS, Sullivan Contracting Services, via its contract with Choice Partners purchasing cooperative, will perform its part of the renovation for a not-to-exceed price of \$59,982.49; and

WHEREAS, staff recommend authorizing the City Manager to execute an Agreement with Sullivan Contracting Services, for the above-stated purposes;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

Part 1. The City Manager is authorized to execute an Agreement with Sullivan Contracting Services in an amount not to exceed \$59,982,49 for renovation of the Police Department's evidence and storage room.
