### **Historical Background**

The City of Seguin has been working with Dan Jackson of Willdan Financial Services since March 3, 2015; on this date city staff was authorized to enter into an agreement with Willdan Financial Services to develop a water and wastewater (W/WW) rate study for the City of Seguin. These studies help ensure that rates charged for service will cover the costs of providing these services. One objective of these studies is to develop a long-term rate plan that will enable the City to recover sufficient funds to meet all operating and capital expenses, meet all debt service and coverage requirements, while at the same time minimizing the impact on the ratepayers.

The initial 2015 study resulted in a scheduled set of rates for both water and wastewater customers through FY 2019-20. Rates were recommended based on projected SSLGC rates, direct and indirect costs, and a Capital Improvement Program that would allow the City to make much needed infrastructure improvements to the City's water distribution, collection, and treatment systems.

Staff has continued to work with Mr. Jackson to help determine rates for the upcoming year and subsequent years. City staff has once again reached out to Mr. Jackson to assist in determining if any W/WW rate adjustments are needed above the rates approved during the FY 2024-25 budget process.

### **Action Requested**

Consider a recommended rate increase for water and wastewater based on this analysis, which included a review of projected SSLGC charges and adjusted W/WW Capital Improvement

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Program. This review determined a proposed five percent increase in water rates and three percent increase in wastewater rates for FY 2025-26.

### **Staff Recommendation**

Staff recommends approval and will be available at the July 15, 2025, Council meeting. Details of this recommendation are included in the tables below.
