Subject: Discussion and possible action regarding naming the 1.3 acres of public parkland that was purchased by the City of Seguin for future pickleball courts located at 418 W. Mountain St.

Date: August 16, 2022

The Parks and Recreation Advisory Board has been discussing the naming of public properties including the future pickleball courts. At their meeting on May 2, 2022, the Parks Board requested City Council direction on the possibility of naming the facility as part of the anticipated October 2022 grand opening/ribbon cutting. At their meeting on May 17, 2022, City Council tasked the Parks Board to solicit and vet possible park names via a city staff led contest.

This public input process resulted in 189 names being suggested for the pickleball courts by the deadline of July 8, 2022. The Parks Board was responsible for narrowing choices received down to 3-5 possible park names for City Council consideration at their August 1, Board meeting. In no order of Board preference, four possible park names listed below were recommended for City Council consideration:

- Seguin Pickleball Complex
- Pecantown Pickleball Park
- Seguin Pickleball Plaza
- Seguin-Saegert Pickleball Complex

City staff recommends approval of one of the four possible park names listed for the 1.3 acres of public parkland that was purchased by the City of Seguin for future pickleball courts located at 418 W. Mountain St.
