A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN EMERGENCY PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH TRC ENGINEERS FOR ENGINEERING AND CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT SERVICES FOR THE DESIGN AND REPLACEMENT OF THE FORCE MAIN THAT FAILED AT THE GERONIMO CREEK WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the cast iron force main that feeds the Geronimo Creek Wastewater Treatment Plant failed on May 4, 2019; and

WHEREAS, city staff was able to repair the failed section, the force main is aged and in need of immediate replacement to avoid another failure; and

WHEREAS, given that the force main is the main feed to the wastewater treatment plant and that the plant's location near Geronimo Creek replacing the force main on an expedited basis is necessary; and

WHEREAS, the City has a duty to operate the Geronimo Creek Wastewater Treatment Plant in a manner that not only provides treatment of waste effluent but also protects the environment and the nearby water sources; and

WHEREAS, the planned expansion of the Geronimo Creek Wastewater Treatment Plant calls for the construction of a second, parallel force main; and

WHEREAS, the construction and installation of both force mains at the same time would result in significant cost saving to the City; and

WHEREAS, city staff recommends entering into a Professional Services Contract with TRC Solution to design a pair of parallel force mains, assist in preparation of bid documents, and manage the construction contract.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

SECTION 1. The City Council of Seguin, Texas hereby approves entering into a Professional Services Agreement with TRC Solutions in the amount of \$97,054.00 for the design and engineering services necessary for the Geronimo Creek Wastewater Treatment Plant Amended Force Main Replacement Project.

SECTION 2. The City Manager is authorized to execute a Professional Services Agreement with TRC Solutions for the Project.

SECTION 3. This resolution is effective on the date of its passing.
