## STATE OF TEXAS

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE PETITION FOR RELEASE FROM THE CITY'S EXTRATERRITORIAL JURISDICTION FILED BY PHILLIP AND KRISTIN KNEUPPER FOR ONE PARCEL OF LAND WITH PROPERTY ID NO. 66152 ALONG OLD SEGUIN-LULING RD, AND GRANTING THE REQUEST FOR RELEASE EFFECTIVE THE DATE OF THE PASSING OF THIS RESOLUTION

**WHEREAS**, during the 2023 session the Texas Legislature passed Senate Bill 2038 wherein a landowner could petition a municipality for release of their property from the City's extraterritorial jurisdiction; and

**WHEREAS**, Phillip and Kristin Kneupper filed a Petition for release from the City's extraterritorial jurisdiction for one parcel of land with Property ID No.66152, totaling approximately 51.210-acres of land located on Old Seguin-Luling Rd, Kingsbury, Texas; and

**WHEREAS**, Phillip and Kristin Kneupper have presented the City with a Petition for Release from the City's extraterritorial jurisdiction that meets the requisites of the Statute; and

**WHEREAS**, the Petition submitted by Phillip and Kristin Kneupper meets the requisites of the new law.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of Seguin, Texas:

- **PART 1.** The Petition for release of one parcel of land owned by Phillip and Kristin Kneupper is accepted.
- **PART 2.** The parcels of land being 51.210-acres situated in the William P King Survey, A-206, Property ID No. 66152, and as more particularly described in the metes and bounds description, is hereby released from the extraterritorial jurisdiction of the City of Seguin.
- **PART 3.** City staff are hereby directed to amend the official maps of the City of Seguin to reflect the above release of land from the City's extraterritorial jurisdiction.
- **PART 4.** This Resolution is in full force and effect beginning October 1, 2024.
