A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS, AWARDING a BID IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,916,973.74 TO E-Z BEL CONSTRUCTION, LLC FOR THE LAWSON STREET RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT THROUGH THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE'S TEXAS RURAL BUSINESS FUND GRANT; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WITH E-Z BEL CONSTRUCTION, LLC. AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City was awarded a \$1,000,000 Texas Rural Business Fund grant through the Texas Department of Agriculture to reconstruct Lawson Street; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to award of said grant, the City issued a Request for Proposals for the Lawson Street reconstruction project, receiving four (4) sealed bids on the Closing Date of July 30, 3034; and

WHEREAS, the four (4) bids ranged in cost from a price of \$1,916,973.74 to \$2,300,300; and

WHEREAS, City Staff, along with Freese & Nichols, the City's consulting engineer for the project, reviewed the four (4) bids, as well as the experience and references for each of the bidders; and

WHEREAS, based on references and experience with similar projects, Staff and the City's consultant recommend awards the bid to the lowest bidder, E-Z Bel Construction LLC.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

SECTION 1. That all the recitals above are true and correct and are incorporated herein as if restated in full.

SECTION 2. The bid for the Lawson Street Reconstruction Project, through the Texas Department of Agriculture Texas Rural Business Fund grant, is awarded to E-Z Bel Construction LLC.

SECTION 3. The City Manager, Steve Parker, is authorized to enter into a construction contract for \$1,916,973.74 with E-Z Bel Construction, LLC for the Lawson Street Reconstruction Project.

SECTION 4. That this Resolution is effective on the date of its passing.
