A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE CITY OF SEGUIN MASTER THOROUGHFARE PLAN

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Seguin desires to support and administer transportation management plans that enhance the quality of life for the citizens of Seguin and the extraterritorial jurisdiction (ETJ); and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Seguin desires to support such transportation management plans for the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Seguin and the ETJ; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Seguin adopted the City of Seguin Master Thoroughfare Plan on May 2, 2017; and

WHEREAS, City staff has identified that an additional railroad crossing between Heideke Street and State Highway 123 Bypass is not practical due to the location of existing crossings; and

WHEREAS, City staff recommends the removal of the King Street / Crossroads Blvd Collector and the Baxter Street extension from Heideke Street to the King Street / Crossroads Blvd Collector; and

WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Commission considered the amendment presented by staff during a public hearing and recommended approval to remove the street extensions as recommended by City staff.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

That the City Council of Seguin, Texas approves the amendment to the City of Seguin Master Thoroughfare Plan to remove the identified King Street / Crossroads Blvd Collector from the Master Thoroughfare Plan and to remove the extension of Baxter Street from Heideke Street to the King Street / Crossroads Blvd Collector as shown on the attached Exhibit.
