AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF SEGUIN, TEXAS AMENDING SECTION 98-109(c), TO AMEND EXISTING PARKING BY PERMIT AREA A; AUTHORIZING CITY STAFF TO PREPARE THIS ORDINANCE AS A SUPPLEMENT TO THE CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the city Council has determined that Section 98-109(c), Parking by permit only, Designated permit areas be amended in order to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF SEGUIN, TEXAS

SECTION ONE. The Seguin Code of Ordinances, Section 98-109(c) is amended to read as follows (<u>underlining</u> indicates added text, <u>strikethrough</u> indicates deleted text):

Sec. 98-109. Parking by permit only.

- (c) Designated permit areas. No person shall park and leave standing any vehicle whether attended or unattended between the times listed and locations designated below without first having obtained a valid parking permit for the designated permit area from the city. Said designated permit area shall be designated as a tow away zone:
 - (1) Area A, daily, year-round.

PASSED UPON SECOND READING on May 7, 2024.

- a. On both sides of North Saunders Street between Medlin Street and West Court Street. On the east side of North Saunders Street at 530 West Court Street; and 107, 203, and 211 North Saunders Street.
- On the west side of North Saunders Street at 206, 210, 214, and 222 North
 Saunders Street; and for 100 feet south of the intersection with Medlin Street.

SECTION TWO. This Ordinance shall become effective beginning ten days after its publication.

SECTION THREE. If any clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed to be unenforceable for any reason, such unenforceable clause or provision shall be severed from the remaining portions of the Ordinance, which shall continue to have full force and effect.

SECTION FOUR. City Staff is hereby authorized to submit this Ordinance as a supplement to the Seguin Code of Ordinances.
