A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS AUTHORIZING A CHANGE ORDER IN THE AMOUNT OF \$255,101.81 FOR THE PHASE I & II STREETS, CURBS, REPAIR OF DRIVEWAYS AND DRIVEWAY PIPE, AND LANDSCAPE MATERIAL – OAK VILLAGE NORTH; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in December 2013, City Council approved an emergency time and materials construction contract, with Jordan Foster for the Phase I street improvements in the Oak Village North subdivision; and

WHEREAS, in March 2014, City Council approved a second emergency time and materials construction contract for the street improvements on the remaining streets (designated Phase II); and

WHEREAS, the project is nearing completion and a Change Order is needed in the amount of \$255,101.81 which includes Phase I & II streets, curb, repair of driveway and driveway pipe that was previously installed and landscape material (sod).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

SECTION 1. The Change Order expenditure of \$255,101.81 for the work to be performed to complete the emergency contracts for the Geronimo Creek Sewer Project Phase V in Oak Village North is approved.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage.
