**AMENDED RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS APPROVING THE APPLICATION FOR A GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$20,800.00 FROM THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR FOR A FY2020 LOCAL BORDER SECURITY PROGRAM; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE SUBMISSION; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

**WHEREAS**, on March 19, 2019, the City Council approved the application to the Office of the Governor for a grant in the amount of 18,000.00 through the then named Border Star Program; and

**WHEREAS**, the police department sought funding to cover the additional overtime costs for interdiction along IH-10 as well as State Highways 46 and 123; and

**WHEREAS**, the Office of the Governor Criminal Justice Division has conditionally approved a FY 2020 Border Star Grant in the amount of \$20,800.00; and

**WHEREAS**, this Amended Resolution approves the application for the amount of \$20,800.00

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Council of the City of Seguin authorizes City Manager, Douglas G. Faseler, to amend the grant from the Office of the Governor for the Local Border Security Program.

**SECTION 2.** The City Council directs and designates the City Manager as the City's Chief Executive Officer and Authorized Representative to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate and act in all matters in connection with the City's participation in the grant program.

**SECTION 3.** The City Council agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Office of the Governor Funds, the City Council assures that the funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor in full.

**SECTION 4.** This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage.
