## **CONNECT SEGUIN**




- Debuted in April 2013 as a deviated fixed route after a year of planning.
- Partnership with the of Community of Seguin to be funded by TxDOT 5311 rural public transportation funds.
- Matching requirement for funding would be provided by the City of Seguin.
- Overarching goal was to provide the community of Seguin greater transportation options and accessibility.









## **CONNECT SEGUIN**



- Effects of Covid–19
  - Reduction in Ridership
    - 20% decrease in ridership system wide
  - Increased Operational Costs
    - PPE for drivers
    - Competitive Pay Increases
    - Increased sanitizing procedures/supplies
- CARES Act Funding
  - Offset additional operating costs/loss revenue
  - Ridership development/planning
    - Connect 46
  - Matching requirement to remain static for FY 2022
