**Subject:** **Resolution releasing properties from the City's ETJ as requested by Roger Hurt for Property ID No.'s 28897, 28901, 28902, and 66005**

**Date:** March 23, 2026

### **Historical Background**

Senate Bill 2038, passed during the 2023 legislative session, provides procedures for a landowner to seek release from a municipality's extraterritorial jurisdiction (ETJ) by filing a Petition with the City. The petition must meet certain requirements to qualify for release.

The City of Seguin has received a request from Roger Hurt to release a total of 7.63 acres of land from the City's ETJ. Roger Hurt is the sole owner of the properties.

### **Action Requested**

Staff is requesting action on the property owner's request to release the subject properties from the ETJ.

### **Recommendation**

Staff has verified that the request meets the requirements of the State statute. Per the State statute, the City of Seguin is required to release the properties from the ETJ.
