A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE PETITION FOR RELEASE FROM THE CITY'S EXTRATERRITORIAL JURISDICTION FILED BY FRED STAUTZENBERGER FOR THREE PARCELS OF LAND WITH PROPERTY ID NO.'S 61152, 61154 AND 61155 ALONG FM 3353, AND GRANTING THE REQUEST FOR RELEASE EFFECTIVE THE DATE OF THE PASSING OF THIS RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, during the 2023 session the Texas Legislature passed Senate Bill 2038 wherein a landowner could petition a municipality for release of their property from the City's extraterritorial jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, Fred Stautzenberger filed a Petition for release from the City's extraterritorial jurisdiction for three parcels of land with Property ID No.'s 61152, 61154 and 61155, totaling approximately 98.845-acres of land located on FM 3353, Kingsbury, Texas; and

WHEREAS, Fred Stautzenberger has presented the City with a Petition for Release from the City's extraterritorial jurisdiction that meets the requisites of the Statute; and

WHEREAS, the Petition submitted by Fred Stautzenberger meets the requisites of the new law.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Seguin, Texas:

PART 1. The Petition for release of three parcels of land owned by Fred Stautzenberger is accepted.

PART 2. The parcel of land being 1.000-acre situated in the J B Johnson Survey, A-191, Property ID No. 61152, and parcels of land being 97.845-acres situated in the William Burnett Survey, A-73, Property ID No.'s 61152, 61154 and 61155, and as more particularly described in the attached metes and bounds descriptions, is hereby released from the extraterritorial jurisdiction of the City of Seguin.

PART 3. City staff are hereby directed to amend the official maps of the City of Seguin to reflect the above release of land from the City's extraterritorial jurisdiction.

PART 4. This Resolution is in full force and effect beginning April 17, 2024.
