A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN TEXAS, AUTHORIZING APPROVAL OF THE ADVANCE FUNDING AGREEMENT FOR VOLUNTARY UTILITY RELOCATION CONTRIBUTIONS ON STATE HIGHWAY IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS (SH 123: 0366-02-089); AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Seguin is a water and sewer provider with facilities located near SH 123 from Cordova Lane to IH 10; and

WHEREAS, in June 2024 the City was notified by TxDOT or its subcontractors that utility relocations are required as part of the SH 123 Expansion Project; and

WHEREAS, the Texas Department of Transportation ("TxDOT") requires that the City enter into a Advanced Funding Agreement ("AFA") for utilities which are affected by the SH 123 Expansion Project; and

WHEREAS, the agreement agrees that it is more economical or efficient for utility relocations to be performed within the State's highway construction contract; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Seguin authorizes the City Manager, Steve Parker, to execute the Advanced Funding Agreement (AFA).

Section 2. The City is responsible for utility construction costs, including any overruns.

Section 3. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage.
