

**A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE SEGUIN THOROUGHFARE PLAN
AND THE NEW BRAUNFELS – SEGUIN REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION PLAN**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Seguin desires to support and administer transportation management plans that enhance the quality of life for the citizens of Seguin and the extraterritorial jurisdiction (ETJ); and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Seguin desires to support such transportation management plans for the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Seguin and the ETJ; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Seguin adopted the Seguin Thoroughfare Plan in conjunction with the Comprehensive Master Plan on October 21, 2008; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Seguin adopted the New Braunfels – Seguin Regional Transportation Plan on August 16, 2011; and

WHEREAS, proposed and existing developments support the following amendment:

1. The reduction of the right-of-way requirement from 180 feet to 70 feet for the segment of FM 725 Arterial from the Outer Loop to the Seguin/New Braunfels ETJ boundary.

WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Commission considered the amendment to the Plans and recommended approval of the amendment as presented herein and as shown on the attached exhibit; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

That the City Council of Seguin, Texas approves the amendment to the Seguin Thoroughfare Plan and the New Braunfels – Seguin Regional Transportation Plan, as presented herein and as shown on the attached exhibit.
