Subject: Ordinance on first reading amending the Seguin Code of Ordinances Chapter 98, Traffic Control Devices, Section 98-40, Designation of No Through Truck Traffic Streets by adding Harper Street to the list; providing for publication of this Ordinance; providing a severability clause; providing for an effective date; and authorizing City Staff to prepare this ordinance for submission as a supplement to the Code of Ordinances.

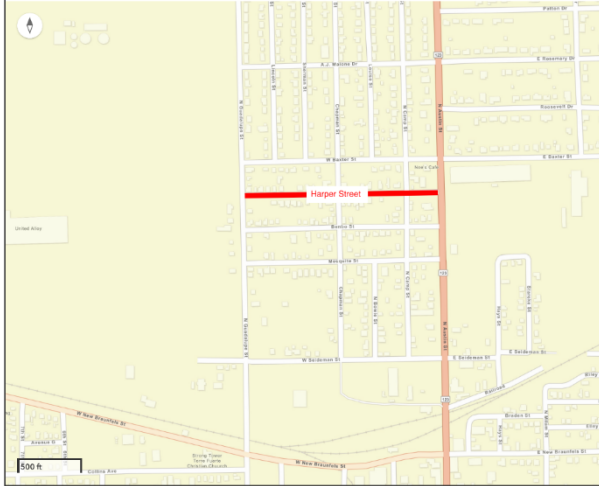
Historical Background

Current City ordinance Sec. 98-40 designates “no through truck traffic” streets as streets with a restriction on through commercial vehicles with two or more rear axles unless they are making a delivery to an address on that street.

Action Requested

Traffic caused by neighboring land uses and connections to N Guadalupe Street and N Austin Street cause an increase in through trucks. However, Harper Street is not identified on the City's Master Thoroughfare Plan and is classified as a local street. Citizens have requested a through truck restriction on Harper Street.

Harper Street is in an area designated by the Unified Development Code as a residential district and not a designated Truck Route, per Sec. 98-43 Truck Routes. Said section prohibits truck traffic from use of non-truck route streets save for specified instances.



Procurement Methodology & Funding Source

There is no fiscal impact associated with this Ordinance.

Staff Recommendation

Staff recommends approval of designation of Harper Street as a No Through Truck Traffic street.
