STATE OF TEXAS

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS, APPROVING A COST SHARING AGREEMENT WITH TYSON FOODS, INC. FOR THE DISPOSAL OF EXCESS SLUDGE PRODUCED AT THE CITY'S WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT.

WHEREAS, during the past winter months the City's wastewater treatment plant that handles, among other customers, Tyson Food's waste water stream accumulated more sludge than normal; and

WHEREAS, in order to dispose of the accumulated sludge the City's treatment costs were increased; and

WHEREAS, as one of the contributors to the City's waste stream, Tyson Foods has agreed to share in the cost of removing the accumulated sludge.

NOW BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

PART 1. The City Council hereby approves of a cost sharing agreement with Tyson Foods whereby Tyson will contribute four monthly payments of \$10,000.00 each to assist in the disposal costs incurred for accumulated wastewater sludge.
