Subject: Resolution of the city council to authorize the spending of more than \$100,000 annually with Precision Infrastructure Management (PIM) Through TIPS Cooperative Contract No. 250503

Historical Background

The Public Works Department is responsible for maintaining the City's roadway drainage infrastructure to ensure the efficient conveyance of stormwater and to preserve the integrity of public streets. Over time, roadways and curb lines can develop low spots, rutting, and surface irregularities that create ponding and standing water conditions following rainfall events.

Precision Infrastructure Management (PIM) provides specialized pavement preservation and drainage restoration services designed to eliminate roadway ponding and improve drainage along curb lines. These services restore positive drainage by removing localized depressions and improving stormwater flow to existing drainage facilities without the need for extensive roadway reconstruction.

The Public Works Department anticipates utilizing these services at various locations throughout the City on an as-needed basis to address drainage concerns identified through routine inspections and citizen requests.

Action Requested

Requesting approval to authorize the City Manager to approve expenditures with Precision Infrastructure Management (PIM) in an amount more than \$100,000.

Procurement Methodology & Funding Source

Procurement of these services will be conducted through the TIPS Cooperative Purchasing Program utilizing Contract No. 250503, which satisfies the competitive procurement requirements of state law and City purchasing policies. Funding for these services will be provided through approved Public Works operating and capital improvement budgets, as applicable.

Recommendation

Staff recommend authorizing the City Manager to approve expenditures with Precision Infrastructure Management (PIM) in an amount not to exceed budgeted funds and in excess of \$100,000, as needed, utilizing TIPS Cooperative Contract No. 250503 for roadway drainage improvement services.
