Subject: Resolution to submit application for the FY2026-2027 State Homeland Security Regular Projects grant program

Historical Background

The Office of the Governor (OOG), Public Safety Office, Homeland Security Grants Division is currently accepting applications for the FY2026-2027 State Homeland Security Regular Projects grant program. The purpose of this program is to efforts to prevent terrorism and targeted violence and prepare for the threats and hazards that pose the greatest risk to the security of Texas citizens

City staff would like to submit an application to this program for a modular vehicle barrier system that can be used to stop vehicles from entering restricted areas during an emergency or public event.

The estimated cost for the barrier system is \$150,000. There is no matching funds requirement for this program. Grant awards are expected to be announced in September of 2026. If the City is awarded this grant, the project will begin in October 2026.

Action Requested

City Council must approve the resolution to authorize the submission of this grant application.

Procurement Methodology & Funding Source

If the grant is awarded, 100% of the funding will be secured through the grant.

Procurements will be made according to the City of Seguin Purchasing Policy and the Uniform Administrative Requirements, Cost Principles, and Audit Requirements for Federal Awards, which is codified in Part 200 of Title 2 of the Code of Federal Regulations.

Staff Recommendation

Staff recommends approval of the resolution to authorize the submission of the grant application.
