Subject: Resolution of the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas approving a proposal from D&D Sitework and Utilities related to the replacement of a 84" corrugated steel storm sewer pipe on Nolan Street; authorizing the City Manager to execute the standard utility agreement; and declaring an effective date.

Date: July 15, 2025

Historical Background

Stormwater from portions of the City drain to the Guadalupe River. One such interceptor is a trunk line that conveys flows from King Street and Court Street to the intersection of Ashby Street and King Street. Water then flows through 78-inch to 84-inch corrugated metal pipes beneath Nolan Street to the outfall at the Guadalupe River. Drainage improvements were constructed in 1985.

On Saturday, July 5th, the City recorded 7 inches of rainfall within a 24-hour period. Two wash-out areas are visible from the street.

Action Requested

Two proposals were requested from contracting companies. However, one contractor was non-responsive. Therefore, staff recommends authorization a proposal from D&D Sitework and Utilities. D&D has performed similar emergency repair work on Saunders Street and currently is the contractor for the Milam Street Reconstruction Project and the Heideke Street Drainage Improvements. The proposal from D&D Sitework and Utilities for repair the storm sewer pipe on Nolan Street is \$199,789.34. Public Works will utilize its paving crew to repair Nolan Street after D&D Sitework and Utilities has completed its work, with an estimated cost of \$30,240.66 for the paving work.

Procurement Methodology & Funding Source

This contract is eligible for exemption from formal procurement pursuant to Section 252.032(a)(1) and (a)(2) of the Texas Local Government Code. All City policies and procedures will be followed for emergency contracts. Funding for this project is provided by the Emergency Fund.

Staff Recommendation

Staff recommends the proposal with D&D Sitework and Utilities be approved for the Nolan Street Emergency Repairs.
